<u>What is a Cub Freeze?</u>: A Klondike Derby style event for teams of Cub Scouts pulling a sled **loaded** with gear and equipment from station to station (town to town) encountering a variety of <u>educational and fun</u> tasks. Similar to the Chuck Wagon Derby, only with sled teams instead of wagon teams.

Location: Treasure Valley, West Lodge & West Camp.

<u>Time:</u> Saturday February 16th, 2013: 8 am - 3 pm. (Alternate date: Sunday February 17th in the event of inclement weather on the 16th.)

Cost: \$7 per participant early registration; \$11 per participant registering on or after Feb. 1

<u>Additional Info:</u> Packs should organize their scouts into sled teams in advance, with 4 - 10 scouts of various ranks (Tiger, Wolf, Bear and Webelos) plus at least two adults per sled. Sleds can be built from most any materials at Den or Pack meetings, or simply a store bought plastic sled. Prior to the event, a check list will be provided for necessary items!!
