Adults may purchase a participation patch for \$1.50

- The Klondike Derby is an event for patrols to participate in by pulling a patrol sled (optional) to various stations to compete for points, which will determine prizes to be awarded at the conclusion of the derby.
- The patrol sled may be of any design you choose but should be adequate enough to carry the required equipment (see list attached). One possible sled design may be seen at <http://scoutdocs.ca/graphics/klondike-sled.jpeg>.
- The maximum size allowed for a patrol to compete will be **8** members. Please split larger patrols into smaller groups.
- Second (2nd) year Webelo Scouts are invited to participate with a patrol providing they follow the guidelines for a day trip with a Scout Troop and the Scoutmaster of the inviting Troop approves of their participation. Even with Webelo Scouts participating please keep patrol size 8 members or under.
- Each unit participating **must** submit an accurate roster of Scouts and adults to the Magee Center on arrival at camp and a second roster to the check in table at the East Lodge.
- At check in at the East Lodge the Senior Patrol Leader for each Troop will receive a packet of information to be passed along to each of his participating patrols.
- **IMPORTANT:** One of the scheduled events at the derby will be the Scouts having an opportunity to shoot at targets at the East Camp Rifle Range. All Scouts wishing to participate in this station **MUST** have the attached permission slip completed and brought to the derby.
- All Scouts must come prepared and properly dressed for the weather conditions. The staff reserves the right to remove participants from competition if not properly dressed.
- Any Scout or adult wishing to submit a patch design for the Klondike Derby may do so. All entries must be turned in to registration table by 2:00pm. All entries should include the name and troop/pack affiliation of the submitter on the reverse side. The staff reserves the right to make changes to the winning design for clarity or other reasons.
- Free hot cocoa and coffee will be served in the East Lodge from 9:30am – 2:30pm.
- Lunch will **NOT** be provided. All patrols are responsible for their own lunch. Lunch may be eaten anytime and anywhere along the trail but please remember to clean up after yourselves.
- Parking is at a premium in the winter at camp. Please carpool to camp.
- Please note that even though for this event there is no late registration fee please register as early as possible so proper program supplies will be available.
- Please note the equipment list attached has been updated to include items that were not on the equipment list passed out at the District Roundtable.
