Please have Registration and Medical Forms filled out to help speed up the registration process.

Registration: Friday night 5:30 PM and Saturday morning 8:00 AM (Events start at 9:15 AM on Saturday). Please have registration form filled out and medical forms ready to speed up the registration process.

Uniforms: Scout uniform (Class A) required for all flag ceremonies.

Be prepared for the weather and temperature.

Event Staff: Each participating Troop is required to provide one adult to assist with the event. These adults will be assigned to help out with specific activities during the day on Saturday. Event Staff adults are not required to pay the registration fee.

Webelos: Webelos Scouts are encouraged to attend the Camporee. Webelos leaders are encouraged to talk to their local Troops about having Webelos Scouts attend the Camporee.

Restricted Areas: There are restricted areas at Felton Field. No scouts or adults are allowed on the Little League and Soccer fields. Scouts and adults not following rules will be asked to leave the event.

Tour Permits: Tour permits are not required but suggested.

Water: Water will be available.

Cooking: This is a perfect opportunity to train your scouts and Patrols in Leave-No-Trace cooking. This is a recommendation and not a requirement.

Quiet Time: The Camporee is located in close proximity to residential areas. Quiet time must be strictly adhered to. Scoutmasters and SPLs are advised to make their Troops aware of quiet time and make sure that all members of their Troops respect this rule.

Fires: Fires in above ground containers are allowed. No camp site fires other than in fire barrels or other above ground fire containers are allowed. Please be sure to have adequate fire buckets available.

Wood: Troops are advised to bring any firewood they may need to this event.
