PARKING

There is adequate parking available. All units are required to submit vehicle counts on the registration form. Vehicles remaining for the weekend and vehicles dropping participants off will have different assigned parking areas for safety reasons.

CAMPSITES

Campsite locations will be assigned based on the registration form.

COOKING

All units are responsible for their own food. No cooking fires will be allowed at this camporee. All cooking must be done on stoves. Remember to bring a fire extinguisher.

WATER

Units should bring water. There will be a limited supply of on site water.

TOILETS

Portable toilets will be available. Use them and **ONLY** them.

GREY WATER

A centrally located grey water disposal area will be provided. Use this and **ONLY** this for grey water disposal. Each unit should bring their own bucket(s) for transporting their grey water to the collection area.

CAMPFIRE PROGRAM

Each unit should submit an item on the registration form, for the Saturday evening campfire. Duplicate entries will be awarded to the first unit registered. The 2nd unit will be contacted to change their submission.

PATCH DESIGN CONTEST

All youth and adult participants are eligible to enter the patch design contest. All entries must have the following items included in the design and be submitted to the administration tent by 11:00am May 21, 2011. Items needed: Quinsigamond District, 2011, fleur-de-lis, Weekend To Win It, submitter's name and unit affiliation on the reverse side of the submission.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES

As of now there are no in site religious services scheduled. If this remains the case, units will have the option of attending services nearby at St Pius X Church, 9:00 am on Sunday located 1 mile from camp or First Congregational Church, 10:00 am on Sunday located 0.6 mile from camp.

The camporee location is private property. Please do not dig trenches. Be sure to remove all tent stakes. Before any unit leaves at the end of the camporee, their site will have to be inspected and approved of, by the camporee staff.

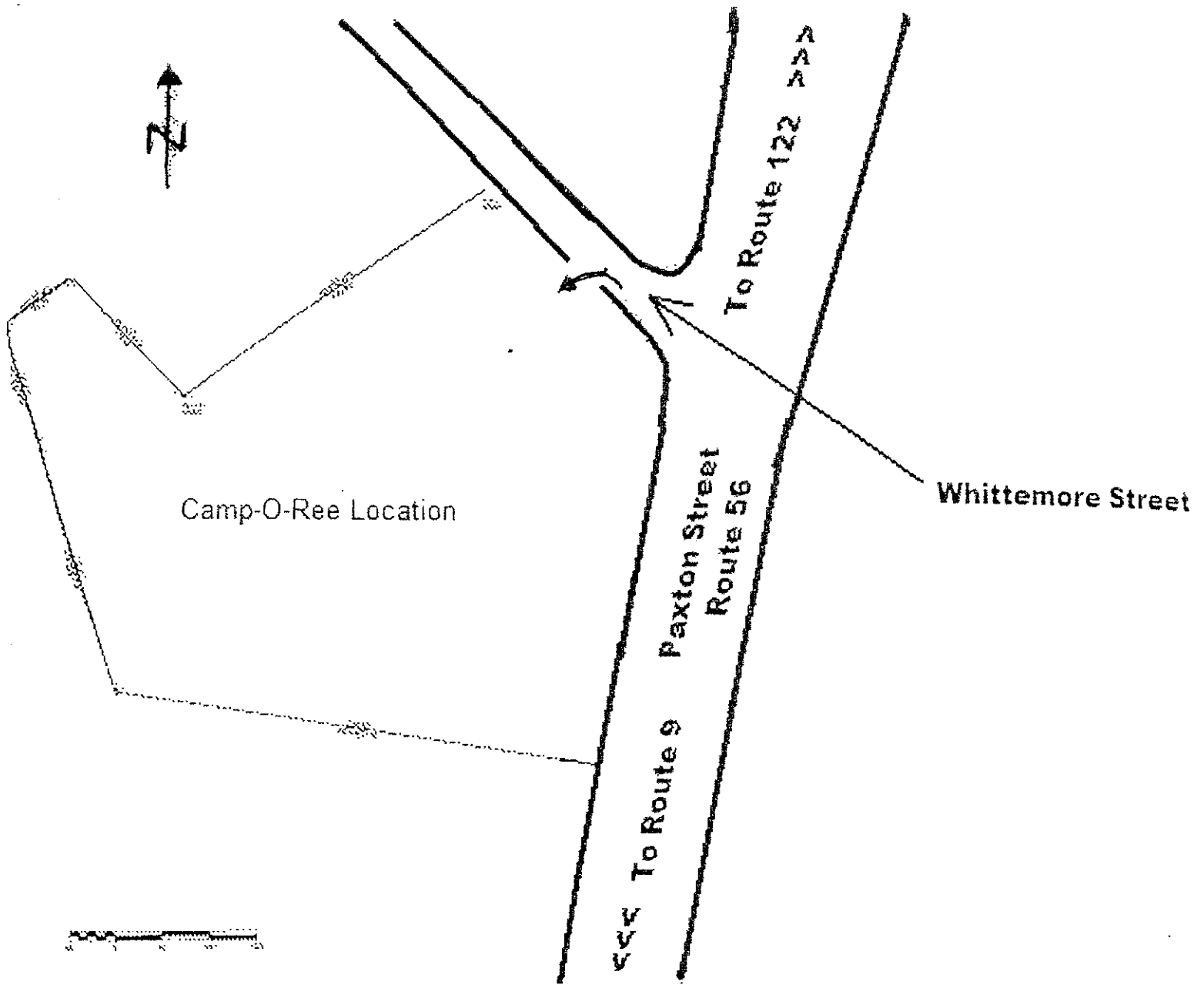
