In preparing to attend camp Scouts and their Parents will want to refer to the information in the **"2011 Campers Guide"**. General information including directions, descriptions of Merit Badge classes, a schedule of activities, check-in/check-out procedures, and health and safety information can all be found therein.

Some merit badges require pre-requisites, please refer to "2011 Campers Guide" and Be Prepared.

All campers are required to have a completed **"2011 TVSR Medical Form"** and signed **"2011 Parent Authorization Form"**. You will need to make an appointment with your physician to complete the Medical Form. It is recommended that you do not wait until the last minute to complete this task as campers with incomplete Medical Forms will be sent home immediately and without a refund. Safety is a priority at Treasure Valley and we do not want to take unnecessary risks.

Provisional Camp- Day Only: (full med form required Parts A,B, and C)
