	Speed Bowline competition	Show how fast you can tie a bowline one-handed or two handed
	Patrol Knot/Log challenge	Patrols work together to lift, move and place a log over distance for time
	Rope Making	Learn the art of Ropemaking
	Field/Patrol Games	Giant Yeehaw
	Dragon Tail	Team work to catch the tail of the dragon to be top dragon
	Poison Stump	Team work to not be “posioned” by coming in contact with the Stump (bucket)
	4-way tug of war	4 teams work to be the first to cross their line
	Ultimate Frisbee	Teams of 6 compete to be the best at a no contact game.
	Cornhole	Teams compete to be the best with bean bags

	Volley Ball	Horizontal Volley Ball Pick up Team will play as needed.
