

Never place your stove, campfire, or other flame source in or near your tent. Never smoke, cook, light, or refuel a stove or any other heat source inside your tent. Death or injury by suffocation, exposure to high concentrations of carbon monoxide and / or serious burns is possible.

Maintain adequate ventilation inside your tent at all times. Death or injury by suffocation is possible. Anchor your tent properly at all times to reduce the risk of loss or injury to the tent or occupants.

When using tent poles (i.e. set-up, break-down), be aware of any / all surroundings in order to reduce the risk of injury to yourself or others.

Consider the possibility of vehicles, falling rocks or tree limbs, lightning strikes, flash floods, avalanches, strong winds, and other hazards when choosing a pitch site to reduce the risk of loss or injury.

Tent meets the CPAI-84 standard for flame retardancy.





Shelter Set-Up (Ground)

*Note: Site Selection: Prior to set-up, ensure area is clear of any and all loose vegetation and sharp objects (i.e. sticks, rocks, etc.).

1. Lay out the shelter with 2. Snap pole ends to four corners of 3. Connect the clear cap clips (2) located at the top of shelter to the cross pole.



4. Connect the shelter clips to the pole (12).




Attaching Rainfly (Ground)




1. Connect the plastic clips (2) located under the rainfly to the cross pole



2. Attach Velcro tabs (4) under the rainfly to the poles.




(4) (Fig. A). Adjust webbing to desired tension (Fig. B)



3. Attach the rainfly corner hooks 4. Stake out shelter. Locate cordage loops (Fig. A) on rainfly (2 front and 1 back) and attach to stakes. Adjust tension by pulling the cord ends (Fig. B).



Shelter Set-Up (Cot)



1. Layout shelter and poles on cot.



2. Wrap hook around cot leg (5) and snap on to locking bar (Fig. A). 3. Follow steps 2 - 4 Open cam buckle and adjust webbing to desired tension (Fig. B). Close cam buckle to lock in place (Fig.C)
